WHEREAS, the people of our nation and our state have an established record of turning to God in times of great challenge and conflict, as well as in times of grief and sorrow;

WHEREAS, in recent days, the law enforcement community, both here in Louisiana and across our nation, are grieving the loss of nine officers who died in the line of duty, as they courageously served their communities;

WHEREAS, men and women in law enforcement are facing greater personal risk as they continue to serve in the midst of a coarsening of our society;

WHEREAS, the Governor of Louisiana, Bobby Jindal, has issued a call to the citizens of Louisiana during "this time of grief" and to "petition the Lord to provide comfort to Louisianans, understanding to families affected by these tragedies, and protection to all law enforcement, as they selflessly serve in the face of danger each day,"

WHEREAS, the Governor has established Monday, September 14, 2015 as a day of statewide prayer for law enforcement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT

The Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice joins in this call and urges the law enforcement agencies of Louisiana to set September 14th as a day of prayer for law enforcement officers, their families, and our state.
